


Measuring Height: Find level, hard ground, ensure the horse is standing squarely with their two front feet next to each other and use a measuring tape to determine the distance from the ground behind the front hoof to the withers. For the most accurate measurement, lay a bubble level across the withers, then use the measuring tape to determine the distance from the ground behind the front hoof to the withers.

Measuring Weight: (left heartgirth x right heartgirth x body length ÷ 300) Use a measuring tape to measure the heartgirth on both the left and right sides. To measure heartgirth, start from the withers and follow the girth line to just behind the elbows of the front legs, stopping centered on the front legs. Next, measure body length. To do so, start at the center of the chest and measure around to the center of the buttock.


